LA TOURNÉE QUÉBEC CINÉMA READY TO LAND IN NOVA SCOTIA!

Montreal, **December 5**, **2018** – La **Tournée Québec Cinéma**, in collaboration with **Radio-Canada**, is delighted to be on the way to Nova Scotia to visit Halifax, Greenwood and Dartmouth. From December 13 to 15, the Tournée will give everyone who loves French-language movies the chance to see feature films and a selection of recent shorts from the **Wapikoni Mobile**. Several guests will also be on hand to meet Nova Scotian audiences.

On December 14, the Tournée will stop in Greenwood for a screening of *La Bolduc* by François Bouvier, a bio-pic about the life of the iconic Québécoise singer Mary Travers Bolduc. At the same time, the team will be in the auditorium of the Museum of Natural History in Halifax with actress Céline Bonnier (Iris Award for Best Supporting Actress) for a screening of *Embrasse-moi comme tu m'aimes*, directed by André Forcier. The film won the award for Best Canadian Film at the 40th Montreal World Film Festival. On December 15, the public will have the chance to enjoy a special selection of short films from the Wakiponi Mobile. Director Katherine Nequado will meet the audience for the first time as she presents short films by young First Nations and Inuit filmmakers – original works made in indigenous communities across Canada. Lastly, fans of Quebec-made films will be invited back to the Museum of Natural History for another screening of *La Bolduc*, with costume designer Mariane Carter in attendance – a great opportunity to discuss the important details to be considered when making costumes for a film set in the early 20th century.

The Tournée's visit to Nova Scotia is made possible by the Alliance Française Halifax, the Conseil communautaire du Grand-Havre, the Association francophone de la Vallée and Halifax Public Librairies.

LAB QUÉBEC CINÉMA JOINS THE TOUR

The **Lab Québec Cinéma** team will take advantage of the Tournée's visit to present a host of activities to young people in Halifax, Greenwood and Timberlea from December 11 to 14. Students at Beaubassin School, Sommet High School in Halifax and Beechville Lakeside Timberlea Sr. Elementary will enjoy short-film production workshops, film analysis sessions and critical debates. They will also see *Ludovic* by Co Hoedeman and *Nelly et Simon: Mission Yéti* by Pierre Greco and Nancy Florence Savard. Students at

Rose-des-Vents School will welcome **director Katherine Nequado**, who will present a **special program from the Wakiponi Mobile**. The Lab's school-based activities help young people develop their analytical and critical abilities while underlining the importance of culture in their learning through workshops, screenings with commentary and master classes.

LA TOURNÉE'S 15th YEAR

The Tournée Québec Cinéma, celebrating its 15th anniversary this year, has travelled more than 170,000 km over the years, bringing Quebec's films and francophone culture to communities across Canada. In its first 15 years, the Tournée has screened more than 700 films in every genre, brought 450 artists to their audience and reached 107,000 audience members throughout the land. And it's far from over! For its 15th season the Tournée will visit every Canadian province and territory outside Quebec for the first time in its history.
