# LA TOURNÉE QUÉBEC CINÉMA NEXT STOP: ORLÉANS!

Montreal, October 25, 2018 – The Tournée Québec Cinéma, in collaboration with Radio-Canada, is heading for Orléans, Ontario, to participate in the 12<sup>th</sup> annual Festival Objectif Cinéma Desjardins presented by the Mouvement d'implication francophone d'Orléans (MIFO). For the occasion, the Tournée team will present a program reflecting the richness and diversity of Quebec's films, with several special guests on hand to meet festivalgoers, from November 8 to 11.

On November 8, cinephiles will have the chance to see Canada's representative for the Oscar for Best Foreign-language Film, *Chien de garde* by Sophie Dupuis, with actor Jean-Simon Leduc present. Leduc recently won the award for Best actor at the Saint Jean-de-Luz International Film Festival. Later the same evening, the Tournée will present *Charlotte a du fun* by Sophie Lorain with actress Romane Denis present. Denis was nominated for Best newcomer at the Gala Québec Cinéma 2018, for her performance as Mégane. The next day, November 9, actor Pierre-Luc Brillant will present *Le nid* by David Paradis, for which he won the award for Best actor at the Festival Les Percéides 2018. There will be two features on the program on November 10: *La chute de Sparte* by Tristan Dubois and *Sashinka*, by Kristina Wagenbauer, with actress Carla Turcotte present. Lastly, the November 11 screening will be *1991* by Ricardo Trogi, concluding the Tournée's visit to Orléans.

### THE LAB QUÉBEC CINÉMA JOINS THE TOUR

The **Lab Québec Cinéma** team will take advantage of the Tournée's visit to the area to present film-themed educational activities to students in Ottawa and Gatineau. The Lab's school-based activities help students develop their analytical skills, critical faculties and highlight the educational value of culture through workshops, screenings with commentary as well as master classes.

### 15 YEARS OF TOURNÉE

Since its inception, the Tournée has travelled more than 170,000 kilometres, bringing Quebec's films and francophone culture to audiences. On its journeys, the Tournée has screened more than 700 films representing every genre, introduced 450 artists working in several film disciplines to audiences, and reached 107,000 spectators across Canada. And that's not all! For this 15<sup>th</sup> season, the Tournée team will bring

Quebec's films to audiences in every Canadian province outside Quebec, as well as two territories, for the first time.
